Follow the green signs Museumpark and Natuurhistorisch Museum. Tram 7 and 8 and Metro (stop Eendrachtsplein) bring you pretty close to the Museumpark.

*Parking?* There is no parking near the museum. We strongly advise you to park your car in the Museumparkgarage. Follow the signs 'P Museumpark' (address for GPS Museumpark 32, 3015 CX Rotterdam). From there it is a two minute walk to the museum/Kunsthal.
